

President's Message



Hello and happy new year AMTOPP members. It is hard to believe the year is over, and January is upon us.

Just a reminder of what we have lined up for the 2020 conference.

First, the days in which the conference is held have changed to January 22-24 (Wednesday – Friday). The change was due to availability of the conference rooms at Fairmont. Hopefully, the change of days will work out for everyone. The board would like feedback from the members on the change of days.

In addition to the change of days, changes have been made to the pre-conference schedule. Typically, the day before the conference, AMTOPP offered ISA testing and First Aid training. Both will continue to be offered. However, there will be additional educational and training opportunities available.

On Wednesday January 22, 2019 there will be two full day workshops. They will begin at 8am and end at 5pm. The first being a Landscape Irrigation Technician Class. The Irrigation Association will provide the training. The other opportunity is an Electrical Hazard Awareness Program. Again, both classes will begin at 8am and end at 5pm. Both classes have limited space so be sure to get signed up, soon.

The following day, Thursday, January 23 at 8 am the opening session will open the annual general meeting and conference. At 8:30 this year's keynote speaker, Donna Gaukler from Missoula's Park and Recreation Department will kick everything off.

Following Donna's keynote, the conference will branch out to several different training and educational opportunities. Each hour will offer several classes to chose from. This arrangement better reflects AMTOPP's diverse membership. AMTOPP's membership includes pesticide applicators, irrigators, arborist, educators, and of course lawn and turf specialist. The board worked hard to provide each with a class specific to their field, however, please feel free to attend any class you would like regardless of your field.

With each hour offering different classes, the number of speakers has grown as well. Please, take the time to talk with and thank the speakers. It is their willingness to share their knowledge that has helped all of us become more knowledgeable and proficient at the work we do.

A tradition that started a few years back will continue on Thursday night during dinner, a "look back" through the year with AMTOPP. This presentation will give everyone a chance to see what all goes on under the AMTOPP name throughout the year.

We have a couple of board vacancies that need to be filled. If you would like to be considered or know someone that you think would be a good prospect, please contact me or one of the board members or the AMTOPP office. The names will be presented during the conference with voting to take place on Friday, January 24, during the lunch period.

Another item that will be coming up for a vote is an Amendment to the By-Laws. 
As always, if you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to contact me or another board member.

AMENDMENT TO THE ASSOCIATION OF MONTANA TURF ORNAMENTAL AND PEST PROFESSIONALS BY-LAWS

Article IV. Board of Directors

Section 4.14 ATTENDANCE

(b) Any Board member missing three or more meetings within a calendar year without prior notification to any Officer or the Executive Director will be asked to resign.

Adoption:

The New By Law reads:

(b) Any Board member missing three or more meetings within a calendar year may be asked to resign. The decision for requesting a resignation will be at the discretion of the board after a review of each absence has been considered. A two-thirds majority vote of board members will be required.
